Brain weighs about 1,350 grams (= 3 pounds)
Range 1,000 – 2,000 grams
IQ does NOT correlate with wt. within normal range
Meninges (DURA MATER, ARACHNOID, PIA
MATER, SUBARACHNOID SPACE)
VENTRICLES, CENTRAL CANAL
CEREBROSPINAL FLUID
